- Select the **Project settings** option

## Configuring contract management options

### Contract Issue Type

This lets you define issue type to use for storing contract.

### Requirements Issue Type

This lets you define issue types to use for storing requirements. You can configure multiple issue types for the requirements.

### Contract-Requirement Link Type

This lets you define link type between contract and requirement.

### Requirement-Negotiation Link Type

This lets you define link type between requirement and various negotiations.

### Custom Fields

You need to select or create two custom fields to store cost of contract, requirement and negotiations.

- **Estimated Cost**
  - Number field to store estimated cost value.
- **Original Cost**
  - Number field to store original cost value.
