

Interactive Depth Mode in Tree View

Links Explorer Traceability & Hierarchy supports interactive depth mode that allows user to expand or collapse the tree view. This feature allows the user to view linked issues across the project at different levels.

By clicking on > icon the user can expand the tree view accordingly.
